

## **COV10 special exhibition by Gennaro Regina**

On the occasion of the COV10 a special exhibition by Gennaro Regina will be set. The Neapolitan artist is also the author of "Suriezione" video-performance, that was part of COV10 presentation during the closing ceremony of Cities on Volcanoes 9, Chile 2016.

Gennaro Regina, born in 1965, came from a family of publishers and antique booksellers. After classical studies, in 1997 he created the "Voyage Pittoresque", a sophisticated space in Naples, where the innovative creativity of his gaze is felt in all his works. Art that he makes his passion consolidated during the years.

This internationally known artist mixes together his two strong passions: painting and photography, creating artworks that fascinate and seduce Italian and foreign collectors. He plays with all the famous and traditional Neapolitan symbols, mixing sacred and profane, like St. Gennaro that see the Vesuvius or the typical Neapolitan horn, huge and propitiatory, that comes from the mouth of Vesuvius
